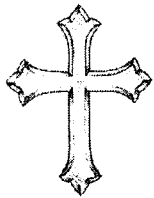

Date	Scripture	Prayer/Praise
Wednesday February 14	Exodus 9:29 I will spread out my hands in prayer to the Lord.	Ask the Lord to guide you through this Lenten season. Pray for yourself and your needs.
Thursday February 15	Deuteronomy 4:7b The Lord our God is near us whenever we pray to him.	Ask God to help you to pray during Lent and to help you feel that He is present in every day.
Friday February 16	Psalm 69:13 But I pray to you, O Lord, in the time of your favor; in your great love, O God, answer me with your salvation.	Pray to the Lord to renew your heart this Lenten season and to remind you of His great salvation.
Saturday February 17	Isaiah 64:9 Do not be angry beyond measure, O Lord; do not remember our sins forever. O look upon us we pray, for we are all your people.	Pray and confess any sins that are standing in the way of growing in the Lord.
Sunday February 18	Psalm 32:11 Rejoice in the Lord and be glad, you righteous; sing, all of you who are upright in heart.	Praise God: List some of the blessings you have because of the goodness of God.

Monday February 19	Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God, The Lord is one.	Pray for the Rainbow Station Staff.
Tuesday February 20	Deuteronomy 6:5 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.	Pray for the Rainbow Station children.
Wednesday February 21	Deuteronomy 6:6 These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts.	Pray for the Rainbow Station parents.
Thursday February 22	Deuteronomy 6:7 Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.	Pray for the Rainbow Station Board.
Friday February 23	Deuteronomy 6:8 Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads.	Pray for the Rainbow Station learning time.
Saturday February 24	Deuteronomy 6:9 Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.	Pray for the Rainbow Station play time and rest time.
Sunday February 25	Psalms 8:2 From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise.	Thank God for Rainbow Station and for the lives of the families that have been changed because of this ministry.

Monday February 26	Psalm 23:1 The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not be in want.	P - Pray for Pastor Julie Kling.
Tuesday February 27	Psalm 23:2 He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters,	A - Ask God to help Pastor Julie as she prepares for the worship services during Lent.
Wednesday February 28	Psalm 23:3 he restores my soul. He guides me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.	S - Seek a way to help in the ministry here at First Presbyterian Church.
Thursday March 1	Psalm 23:4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.	T - Take time to pray for wisdom as Pastor Julie leads this congregation
Friday March 2	Psalm 23:5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cups overflow.	O - Open your eyes, ears, heart and mind to the messages God is sharing through Pastor Julie.
Saturday March 3	Psalm 23:6 Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.	R - Read all of the words of Psalm 23 and pray for Pastor Julie as she seeks God's guidance in her ministry.
Sunday March 4	John 10:11 I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.	Thank Jesus, the Good Shepherd, for his love and care.

Monday March 5	Matthew 16:13b "Who do people say the Son of Man is?"	Pray for the Elders of First Presbyterian Church. Ask God to guide them as they minister.
Tuesday March 6	Matthew 16:14 They replied, 'Some say John the Baptist; other say Elijah and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets.'	Pray for the Deacons of First Presbyterian Church. Ask God to help them as they serve.
Wednesday March 7	Matthew 16:15 But what about you? He asked. Who do you say I am?	Pray for The Leadership Committees and for the work they do in the church and the community.
Thursday March 8	Matthew 16:16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God."	Pray for the worship services at First Presbyterian Church. Pray that God is magnified.
Friday March 9	Matthew 16:17 Jesus replied, Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by man, but by my Father in heaven.	Pray for the members and friends of First Presbyterian Church.
Saturday March 10	Matthew 16:18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.	Pray for those God is calling to be a part of the fellowship here at First Presbyterian Church.
Sunday March 11	Psalms 52:9 I will praise you forever for what you have done; in your name I will hope, for your name is good. I will praise you in the presence of your saints.	Thank God for First Presbyterian Church. Thank him for his faithfulness.

Monday March 12	Philippians 4:5 Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.	Pray for the Liberty Center, their staff and volunteers.
Tuesday March 13	Philippians 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.	Pray for the Alcoholics Anonymous Groups that meet in the church.
Wednesday March 14	Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.	Pray for the VIDA church that meets on Sunday evenings at the church.
Thursday March 15	Philippians 4:8 Finally brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things.	Pray for Habitat for Humanity who has an office in the church.
Friday March 16	Philippians 4:9 Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me - put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.	Pray for the Neighbors program with the Food Pantry and Share and Care ministries in Fremont.
Saturday March 17	Philippians 4:13 I can do everything through Him who gives me strength.	Pray for church members who volunteer in the community.
Sunday March 18	Philippians 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!	Thank God for using this building and the members and the friends of First Presbyterian church to minister in this community.

Monday March 19	Romans 8: 1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,	Pray for the areas that were affected by wildfires this year.
Tuesday March 20	Romans 8:2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death.	Pray for the areas affected by hurricanes this year.
Wednesday March 21	Romans 8:3 For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in sinful man,	Pray for people suffering from addiction to drugs or alcohol.
Thursday March 22	Romans 8:4 in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit.	Pray for those who are hungry or in poverty.
Friday March 23	Romans 8:16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.	Pray for those who have the flu and their families, especially those who have suffered a loss.
Saturday March 24	Romans 8:17 Now if we are children, then we are heirs - heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.	Pray for those who have cancer or another illness, especially those with a terminal illness.
Sunday March 25	Romans 8:18 I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.	Praise God for the Glory that is greater than the suffering.

Monday March 26	Matthew 26:38 The he said to them, "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me.	Pray for the people in Europe.
Tuesday March 27	Matthew 26:39 Going a little further, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will."	Pray for the people in Asia.
Wednesday March 28	Matthew 26:41 "Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing but the body is weak."	Pray for the people in Africa.
Thursday March 29	Matthew 28:5 The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified.	Pray for the people in North America.
Friday March 30	Matthew 28:6 He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.	Pray for the people in South America.
Saturday March 31	Matthew 28:7a Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He is risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.'	Pray for the people in Australia and Antarctica.
Easter Sunday April 1	Mark 16:15 He said to them, Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation.	Thank the Lord for his salvation and ask him to use you to tell the good news.
