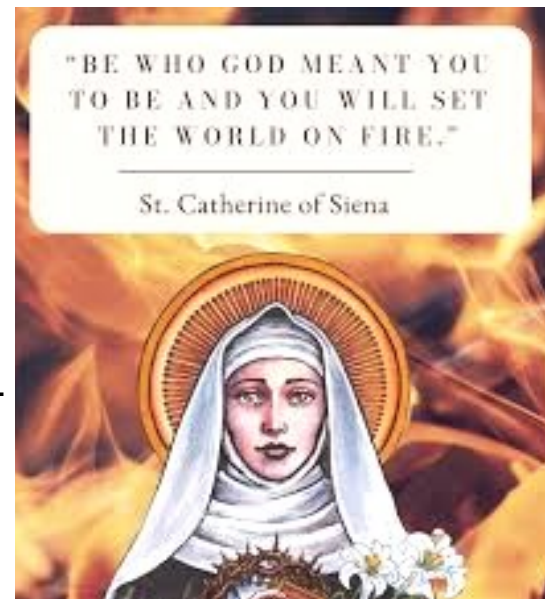
Pastoral Reflection

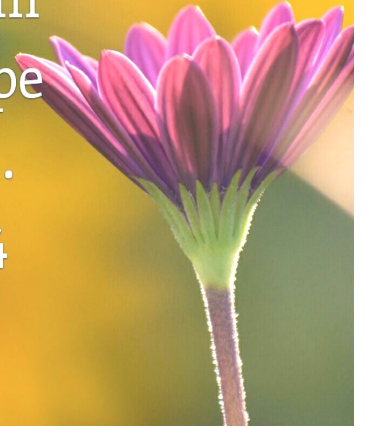
