### **MONTHLY REFLECTION**

### Peter had it Right!

As I was preparing for the installation of Elders and Deacons for our upcoming year, I happened to run across writings in the Book of Peter that seemed quite appropriate for those that had volunteered to serve and for the rest of the congregation as well.

First Peter was written by Peter, one of the original twelve disciples, to the Christians who lived in the northern part of Asia Minor. These Christians were being persecuted for their faith, so Peter wrote to encourage them.

He urges them to remember how much Jesus suffered for them and to follow his example by trusting God to care for them. Because God chose them to be his people and because Jesus died for them, Peter tells these Christians they should live holy lives. He goes on to tell them how they can live as Christians in this world and have hope for the future.

In chapter 5, verses 1-5, Peter writes: To the elders among you, I appeal as a fellow elder, a witness of Christ's sufferings and one who also will share in the glory to be revealed: Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, serving as overseers—not because you

must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not greedy for money, but eager to serve; not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock. And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away. Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility towards one another, because, "God opposes the proud. but gives grace to the humble."

Good words to always live by.
