MONTHLY REFLECTION

When God closes a door...

On September 14, 2025, the last worship service will be held in the sanctuary of the First Presbyterian Church at 120 South Park Avenue, Fremont, Ohio. Thanks be to God for all the love and special memories that have taken place within these walls.

We arrived at this day through the work of the Sessions of First Presbyterian Church and East Side Presbyterian Church and the appointed Transition/Visioning Team.

The Transition/Visioning Team members were tasked to envision a merged church. The members took time to analyze the current operations of both churches, the buildings, the staff, and all the "stuff" in the buildings. Great care was taken to analyze the costs of operating the buildings, the anticipated repairs and maintenance for the next 10 years, and the size of the anticipated new congregation. In the end, the team recommended using the East Side building for the new congregation.

Since the proposal to merge and the steps laid out to begin making the two congregations into one new church was approved, both congregations have taken on the work of merging traditions, sacred items, staff members and duties, and the "stuff."

In July, the new joint Session started meeting to work on creating this new congregation. A high

priority was making the space "ours" by including traditions and sacred items that have held importance in the former congregations. One of the first tasks was to select a name that reflects this new congregation. Starting January 1, 2026, the church located at 1020 Kentucky Avenue will be known as Fremont Presbyterian Church. The Grand Piano will be moved from the First Presbyterian Building. Work has begun to combine the libraries, the kitchens, the music, and the nurseries, finalize a space for the Secretary, and obtain internet service.

Looking forward, the new congregation will be able to discern the best way to meet the spiritual needs of the members and friends and reach out to invite others to share our love of God.
